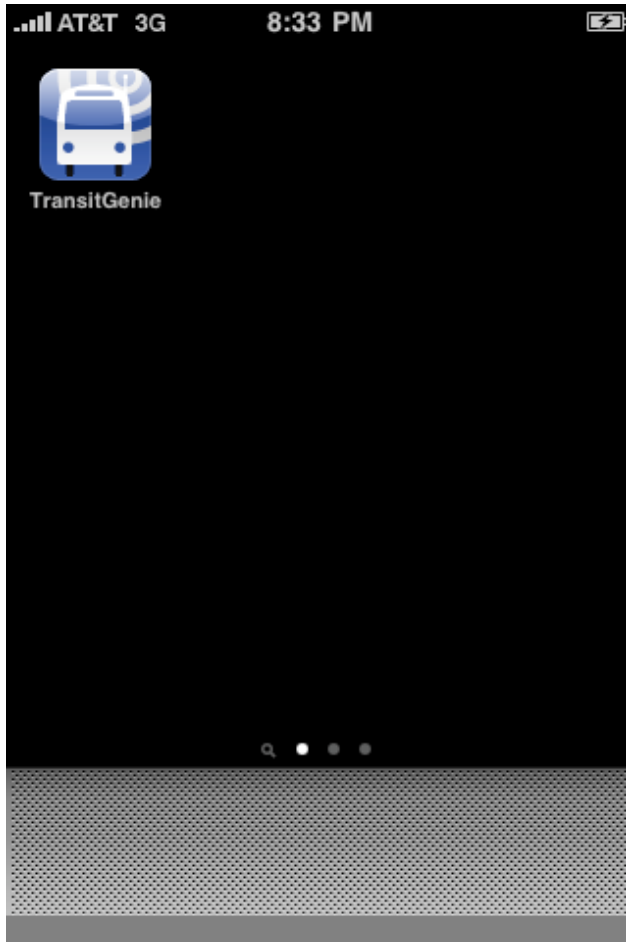

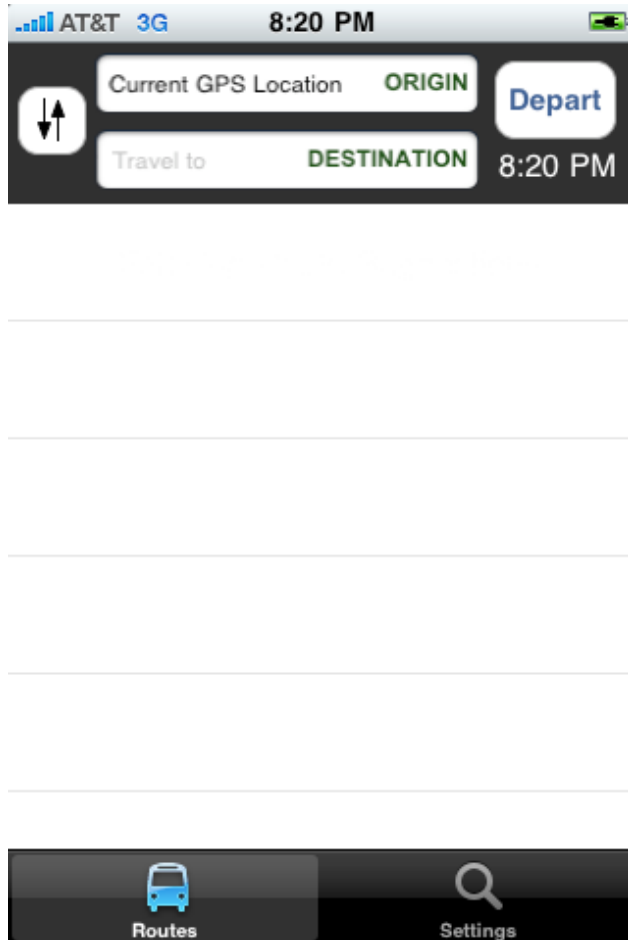

How to start TransitGenie



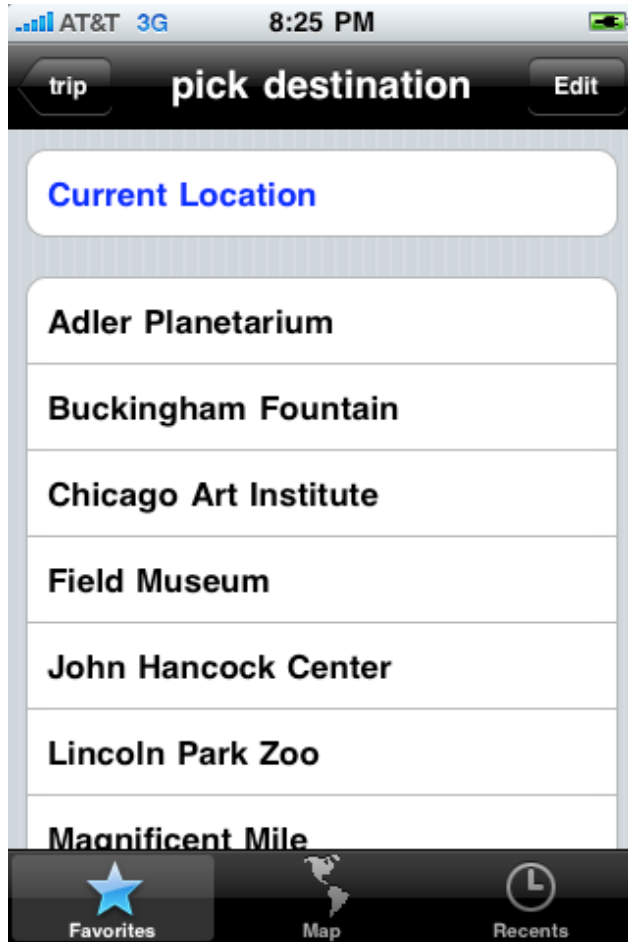
- Click on the “TransitGenie” icon

How to select your Origin



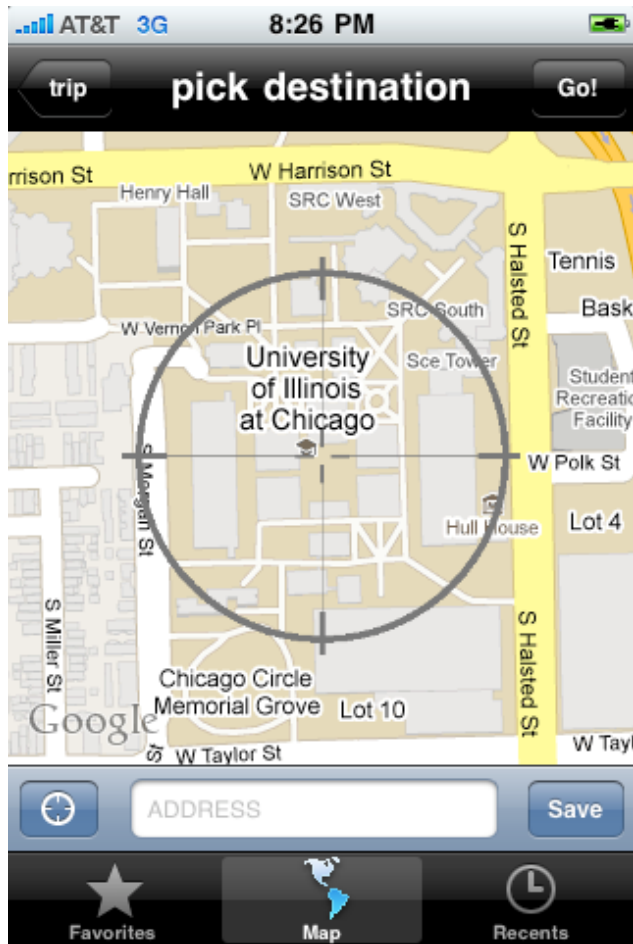
- By default, your Current GPS Location is used as your origin location
- You can set your origin/destination by selecting the respective location text box
- Selecting an origin or destination follows the same procedure

How to select a Destination



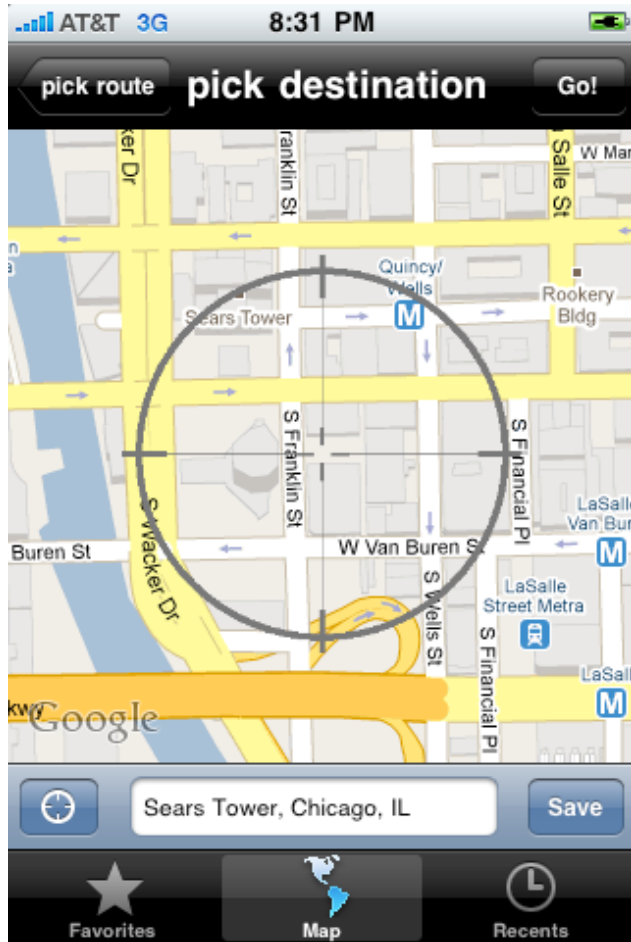
- Select your current GPS location by pressing “Current Location”
- Or, select a “Favorite” location from the list

How to select a Destination



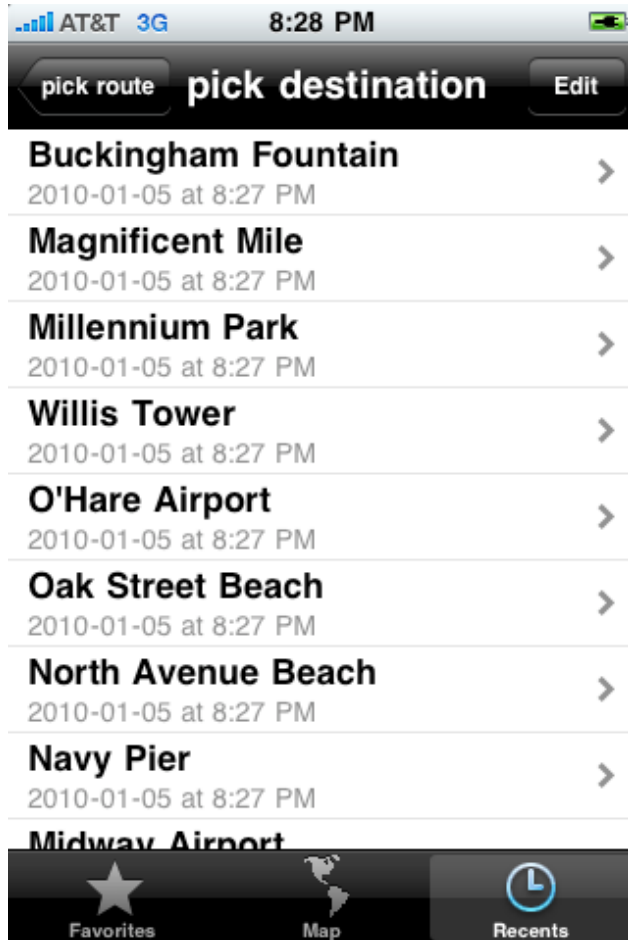
- Press the “Map” tab at the bottom of the screen, and select a location on the map
- You can save your location to the “Favorites” list using the “Save” button

How to select a Destination



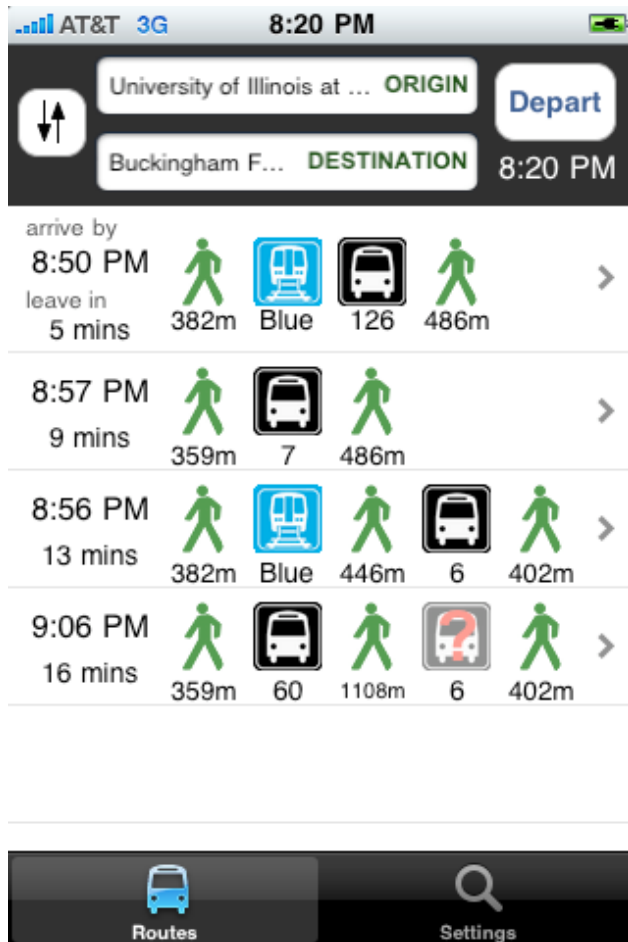
- Type an address into the “Address” space in the lower menu bar
- You can save your location to the “Favorites” list using the “Save” button

How to select a Destination



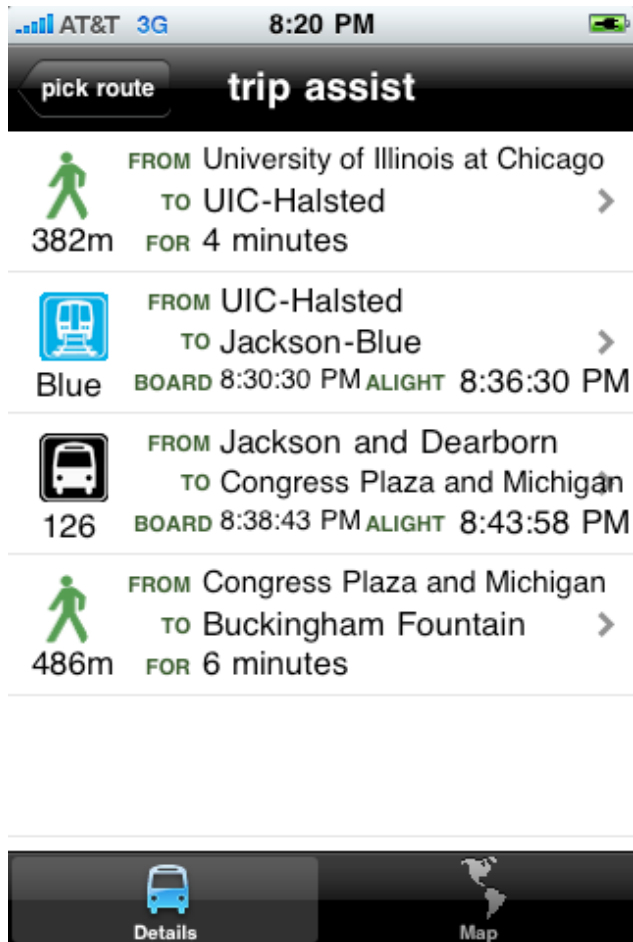
- Press the “Recents” tab at the bottom of the screen, and select a recently visited location

How to select a Route



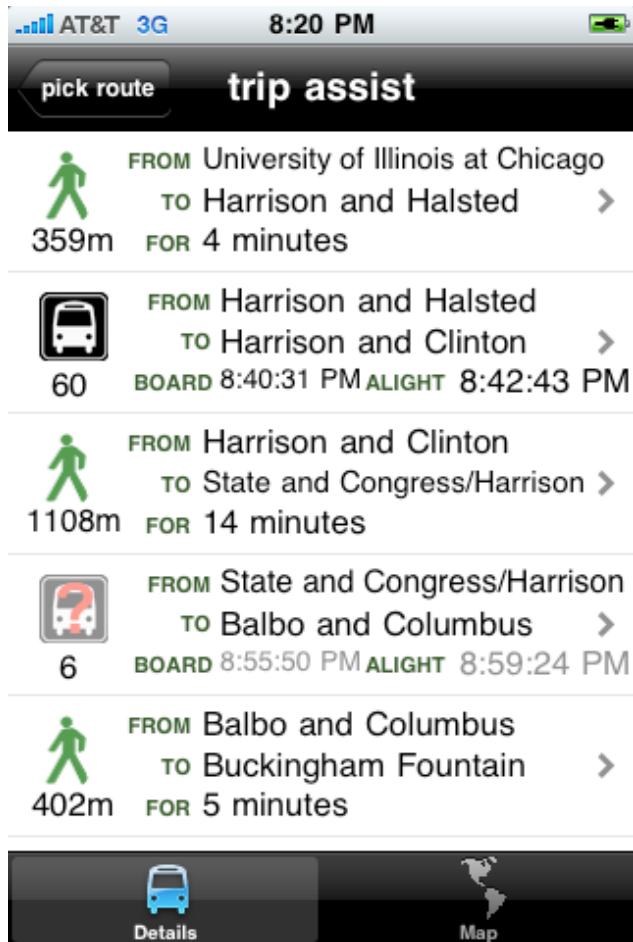
- Once an origin and destination has been specified, the four best routes are displayed in summary form
- The estimated time of arrival (ETA) and time until you need to depart are listed in each row
- Select a row for detailed route information

Viewing detailed Route information



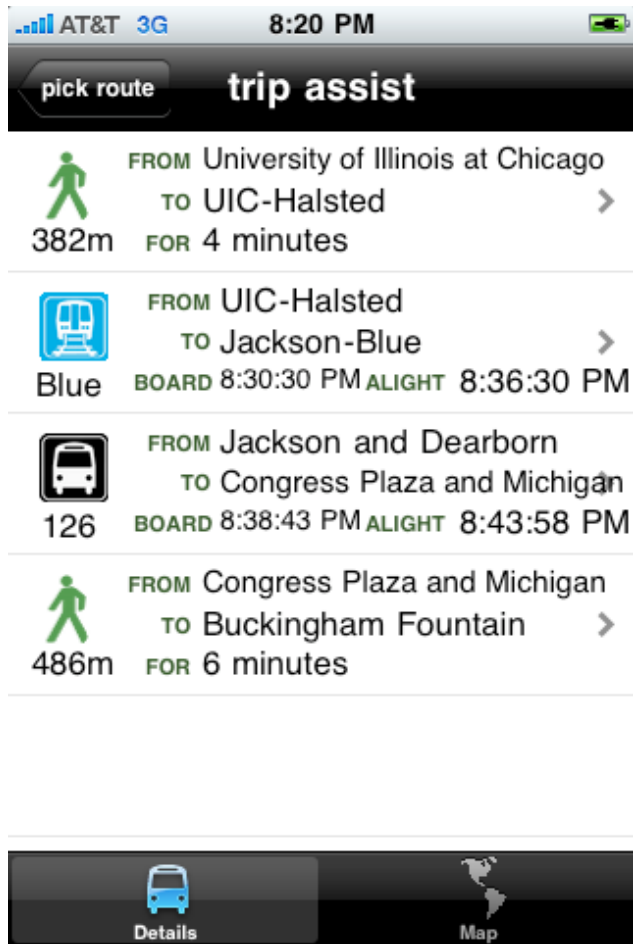
- This screen displays detailed route information
- The direction and duration of walk legs are listed, as is the board/alight information for each mode of transportation

Viewing detailed Route information



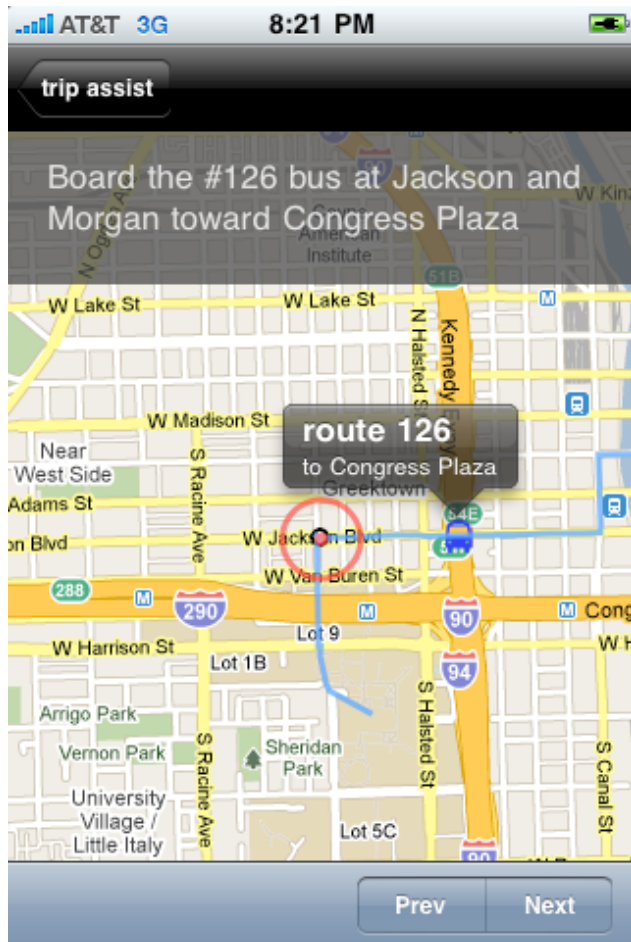
- Buses using real-time verified departure/arrival times have black icons
- Buses using scheduled departure/arrival times have grey icons
- Buses whose departure/arrival times are in question have a question mark atop them

Viewing route information on Map



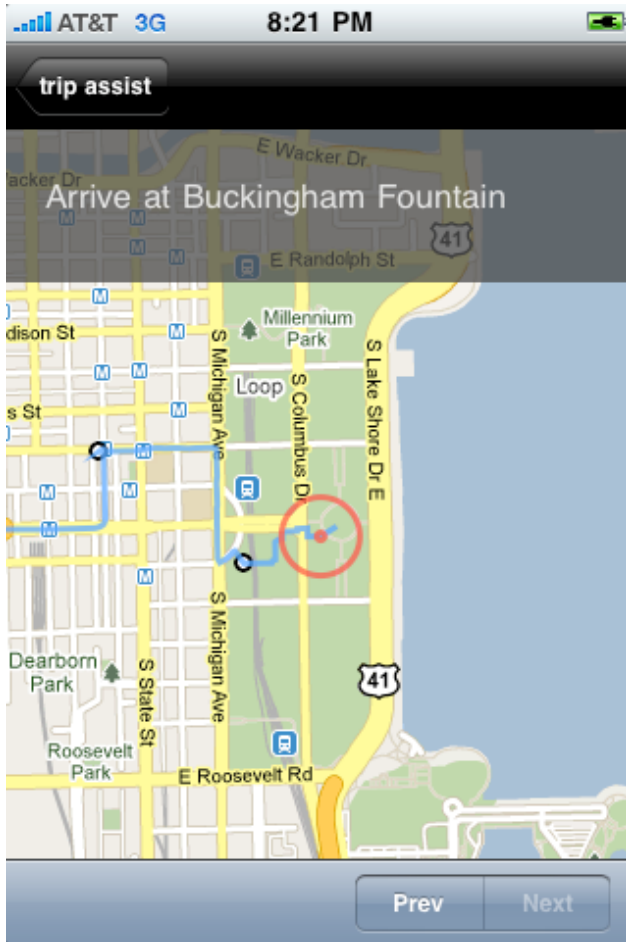
- To view the route information displayed on a map, select the “Map” tab at the bottom of the screen

Viewing route information on Map



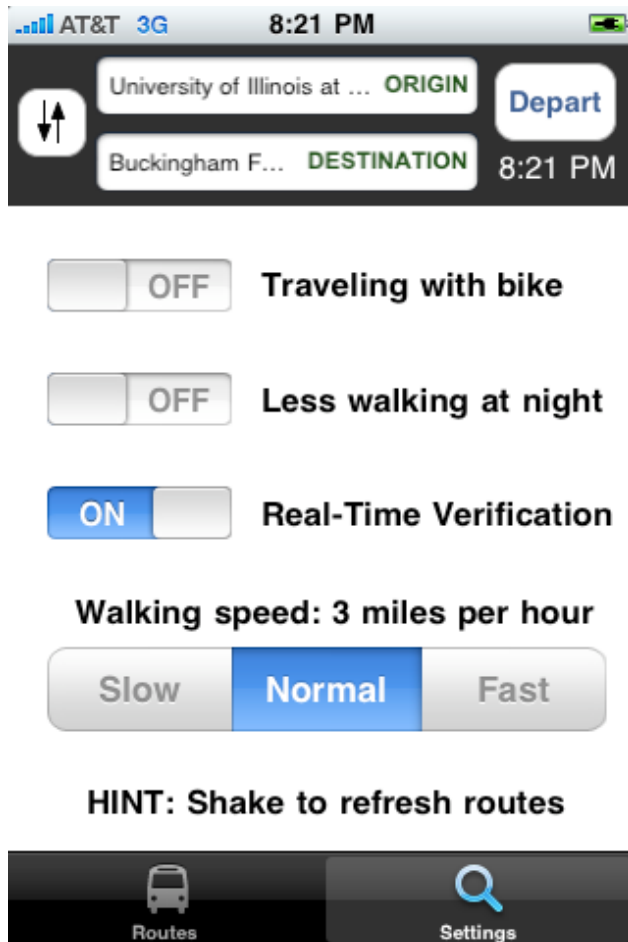
- The map displays step-by-step instructions for navigating from origin to destination
- Use the Prev/Next buttons to step through the route
- Map also displays real-time location of relevant buses

Viewing route information on Map



- Once you have reached your destination on the map, the “Next” button will be grayed out

Personalization options



- From the main “Routes” screen, select the “Settings” tab at the bottom of the screen
- Here you can select your preferences for a personalized routing experience
